Proclamation of Seeds Act and Its Regulations (2022)

The Seed Act which regulates the import, export and trade of seeds has come into force as from 02 September 2024. It, *inter alia*, provides for all seed dealers/producers/importers and exporters to be mandatorily registered with the National Plant Varieties and Seeds Office (NPVSO), operating under aegis of the Ministry of Agro-Industry and Food Security.

In this respect, the NPVSO will as from 13 January 2025.

- (a) register seed dealers, seed producers, and seed varieties, and
- (b) consider applications for:
 - (i) certification of a seed crop;
 - (ii) seed sampling and testing of a seed lot; and
 - (iii) import/export permit of seeds.

Necessary registration/application forms may be collected from the office of the NPVSO/Agronomy Division, Reduit or may be downloaded from the website of the Ministry at https://agriculture.govmu.org.
